



LETTER OF INTENT TO ESTABLISH OKLAHOMA RESIDENCE

Policy: Pursuant to Title 38 of the United States Code (U.S.C.) 3679(c), individuals using educational assistance under Chapter 31, Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment (VR&E), will be eligible for in-state status if she/he files, with the institution within the State System at which the student intends to register, a letter of intent to establish residence in the state along with residing in the state while enrolling in the institution. These individuals will maintain their "In State" status as long as they remain continuously enrolled at Oklahoma State University.
