Other Requirements:

Exit interview with Head of Department of Agricultural Economics. A minimum of 40 semester credit hours and 100 grade points must be earned in courses numbered 3000 or above. A 2.00 GPA or higher in upper-division hours. No more than 60 hours may be transferred from a two-year program.
